I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink,



## A MESSAGE FROM MIKE

This was not the message that was originally supposed to be in this month's Long Island Footnotes.

As we were putting the final touches on this month's magazine, we learned that our good friend – our great and glorious friend – Bill Benson had passed away.

Bill was an amazing human being, and an inspiration to everyone. He was the ultimate answer to anyone who has



said that he or she is too old to run, too old to continue to be physically active. As recently as last year he was running 5 kilometer races, including the Heart & Sole 5K and the Carter, DeLuca, Farrell & Schmidt Ho Ho Ho Holiday Run in December. Bill's favorite race was the Fifth Avenue mile, which he had run for the past 16 consecutive years, and in 2015 he became the oldest runner to finish that event. Bill had been looking forward to running in the 2016 edition of the Fifth Avenue Mile but, sadly, that was just not to be.

We were thrilled to have been able to celebrate Bill's recent milestones with "Bill Benson's 90th Birthday Run" in June of 2009 and "Bill Benson's 95th Birthday Run" in June of 2014.

Bill never gave in to what others might call old age. He obviously was aware of his growing physical frailty, but he never let it stop him from enjoying the sport that he had loved for so many years. He never let anything interfere with his good humor and his positive outlook on life. He never lost the twinkle in his eye.

Bill was a frequent contributor to this magazine for many years, giving us statistics and insights into the exploits of local athletes and their relation to the overall National running scene.

Bill loved life...and he loved it to the very end. Although his body was failing him, Bill had the good fortune to be in full possession of his faculties and his wit to the wery end. All of us can only hope to cross that final Finish Line in the same manner as Bill was fortunate to have done.

That's it for now. Just remember to think good thoughts about our friend Bill from time to time. I know that I will.
