Many thanks also to all of our worship servers (acolytes, lectors, assisting ministers, ushers, and Zoom hosts) including the Confirmation students who did an awesome job serving in these roles on Mother's Day! If you would like to serve in worship or have any questions about the roles listed above, please speak with me. We just trained some new acolytes a few weeks ago who are very eager and excited to serve, but we can definitely arrange for more training this summer if needed!

Speaking of summer, there is much to look forward to here at SJILC in the coming months, from baptisms and Bible studies to Confirmation and VBS, just to name a few! Other hopes and possibilities for this summer include hosting another luncheon for the senior citizens at Greis Park in July, a youth retreat to Camp Koinonia, and a congregational outing to either a Long Island Ducks or Brooklyn Cyclones baseball game. More details on these events to follow.




