A Message from Pastor Alex:

"Welcome one another, therefore, just as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God." – Romans 15:7

One of the things that I love about St. John-Incarnation is that we really do strive to be a welcoming church! It's written on our sign by the front doors – "Join us! All are welcome!" – and upon entering the building, what's the first thing you see straight ahead? The statue of Christ in the Memorial Garden. Christ with His loving arms reaching out and welcoming us in.

And so, as the body of Christ and disciples of Jesus, we extend that welcome to all who join us for worship, whether they are lifelong members or first-time guests. We make sure that every person is greeted and handed a bulletin, and with the help of our fantastic ushers, they are guided to an empty pew or directed to the restroom, if needed. And, of course, when someone wishes to become a member of the congregation, we welcome them and joyfully give God our thanks and praise! That is exactly what we will do on Sunday, June 1, as we officially welcome Michael Grahlfs, Joseph and Donna Masciello, and Jenny Rudolph as our newest members at the 9:30am service! Please join us if you can and make sure to introduce yourself when you see them. Thank you!

The following Sunday, June 8 is Pentecost, the day in which we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the church. Our celebration that morning will also include the rite of Confirmation for Sam Barry, Bobby Clark, and Irina Sargent who will be publicly affirming their baptism at the 9:30am service. Please make sure to wear red that day or you won't be welcomed into church! (*Just kidding*)

Paul reminds us that we are called to welcome one another just as Christ welcomes us, but as Christians we are also called to evangelize and invite! How can we tell others about the love of God revealed in Jesus Christ? It can be intimidating to talk about our faith, to be sure. The fear of being ridiculed or rejected is a very real thing. However, perhaps our witness can be as simple as an invitation: "Come and see." Come and see what God is doing in your life and in the life of this congregation! Come and hear the good news of Jesus and His love for all people! Looking for a new church home? Come and check us out! ... Can we be that kind of church? A community of faith that actively invites and shows hospitality to all who come through our doors?

Fortunately, summertime at SJILC offers plenty of opportunities for you and I to invite others to "come and see." We started at the Memorial Day parade by distributing well over 100 bottles of water with our church's information attached. In addition to our weekly Sunday worship, we will also be having our annual summer barbeque sponsored by WELCA on Tuesday, June 17 at 6:00pm. Why not bring a friend or neighbor? All are welcome!

Another option is our Summer Bible study which will begin on Thursday nights in July and continue throughout August and into September. The reason for this is that I picked a new series from Augsburg Fortress on the book of Romans that is designed for eight sessions but it's still on pre-order until July 1. It looks very interesting and it's discussion-based too, which should be more engaging for everyone. So taking VBS into consideration, the tentative dates I'm planning will be July 10, July 17, July 24, July 31, August 14, August 21, August 28, and September 4.

We will meet from 7:00 to 8:00pm in the Council room and also via Zoom for those who want to attend virtually. And again, feel free to invite others!

Speaking of VBS, if you haven't yet heard, our theme for this year is "Magnified! — Discovering the BIGNESS of God in the smallest of things." Dates are August 4, 6, and 8 from 6:30pm to 8:30pm. More details and registration forms will be available soon, but if you're interested in helping out, our first planning meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 11 at 7:00pm. Any questions, please ask me or our other VBS co-director, Gabrielle Barry. We also hope to have some posters made up to promote our VBS, which we'll make available for you to post and share. Thank you in advance for helping us spread the word!

Yes, it feels good to be invited. I mean, we all want to be included, right? That's what makes getting an invitation special! Many of you are members of SJILC because someone invited you and made sure you felt welcomed from the start.

So as we follow our Lord's Great Commission to go and make disciples (remembering that He is with us always to the very end!), let us be both a welcoming <u>and</u> an inviting church. If you know someone without a church family, invite them to join ours! Offer to drive the first few times or come early and greet them in the narthex as they come in. At the very least, make sure you're present to accompany that individual or family. After all, it can be intimidating to enter a church that you've never stepped foot in, especially when you don't know anyone! You can help ease that anxiety/fear just by being you — a familiar face. Sit with them. Invite them out to lunch afterward. Enjoy some fellowship together, and who knows, maybe a new friendship will blossom in the process!

No, we can't drag people into our church or force them to worship with us, but we can invite and welcome them in the name of Jesus – the One who invites and welcomes all people including you and me. This is part of our mission here at St. John-Incarnation Lutheran Church. May we continue to share the good news, and by the power of the Holy Spirit, may God continue to help us and all believers make disciples of every nation.




